HERE ARE THE SCRIPTURES WHERE JESUS TALKS ABOUT THE END TIMES

Here's a list of all the key passages where Jesus speaks about the end times, primarily from the Gospels. These include references to the Rapture, Tribulation, Second Coming, and the Final Judgment.

1. The Olivet Discourse (Jesus' Most Detailed Teaching on the End Times)

 **Matthew 24-25, Mark 13, Luke 21**

- This is Jesus' longest and most detailed prophecy about the end times.

- He discusses wars, famines, earthquakes, false prophets, persecution, the abomination of desolation, the Tribulation, and His return.

Key Verses from the Olivet Discourse

◆ Matthew 24:3-8 – Signs of the End Times

"And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world? And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many. And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places. All these are the beginning of sorrows."

◆ Matthew 24:29-31 – The Second Coming of Christ

"Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken: And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other."

◆ Matthew 24:36-44 – No One Knows the Day or Hour

"But of that day and hour knoweth no man, no, not the angels of heaven, but my Father only. But as the days of Noe were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come."

◆ Matthew 25:1-13 – The Parable of the Ten Virgins (Readiness for His Return)

"Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh."

◆ Matthew 25:31-46 – The Sheep and the Goats (Final Judgment)

"When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory: And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats."

2. Other End-Times Teachings of Jesus

Jesus Describes the Rapture-Like Event

◆ Luke 17:26-35

"And as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of man... Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed. In that day, he which shall be upon the housetop, and his stuff in the house, let him not come down to take it away... I tell you, in that night there shall be two men in one bed; the one shall be taken, and the other shall be left. Two women shall be grinding together; the one shall be taken, and the other left. Two men shall be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left."

Jesus Warns About the Tribulation

◆ Mark 13:19-20

"For in those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be. And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he hath chosen, he hath shortened the days."

Jesus Promises to Return for His People

◆ John 14:1-3

"Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also."

Jesus' Warnings About the Antichrist and False Prophets

◆ Matthew 24:24

"For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect."

◆ John 5:43

"I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive."

- This is sometimes interpreted as a reference to the Antichrist, whom the world will accept instead of Christ.

3. Jesus' Warnings About Being Ready

◆ Luke 21:34-36

"And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch ye

therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man."

◆ **Revelation 22:12 (Jesus' Final Words on His Return)**

"And, behold, I come quickly; and my reward is with me, to give every man according as his work shall be."

Summary

- **Isaiah 13:9-11** – Prophecy of global distress and God's judgment.
- **Jeremiah 30:7** – "The time of Jacob's trouble."

B. The Rise of False Christs and Deception

◆ **Matthew 24:11, 24 / Mark 13:22**

"And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many... For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall shew great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect."

► **Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:**

- **Daniel 8:23-25** – Prophecy of a deceitful ruler (foreshadowing the Antichrist).
- **Zechariah 11:16-17** – Prophecy of a worthless shepherd (Antichrist).

C. Persecution of Believers

◆ **Matthew 24:9-10 / Mark 13:9-13 / Luke 21:12-19**

"Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake."

▶ **Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:**

- **Daniel 7:21, 25** – The Antichrist makes war with the saints.
- **Psalms 2:1-3** – Nations rage against God and His people.

D. The Gospel Preached to All Nations

◆ **Matthew 24:14 / Mark 13:10**

"And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come."

▶ **Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:**

- **Isaiah 52:10** – "The Lord hath made bare his holy arm in the eyes of all the nations."
- **Psalms 22:27** – "All the ends of the world shall remember and turn unto the Lord."

E. The Abomination of Desolation (Antichrist in the Temple)

◆ **Matthew 24:15-16 / Mark 13:14**

"When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains."

▶ **Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:**

- **Daniel 9:27** – The Antichrist will set up the abomination in the temple.
- **Daniel 11:31** – Forces shall pollute the temple and take away daily sacrifices.

F. The Great Tribulation (Unprecedented Suffering)

◆ **Matthew 24:21-22 / Mark 13:19-20**

"For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened."

▶ **Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:**

- **Jeremiah 30:7** – "Alas! for that day is great, so that none is like it."
- **Daniel 12:1** – "There shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation."

G. Cosmic Signs and Jesus' Return

◆ Matthew 24:29-30 / Luke 21:25-27 / Mark 13:24-26

"Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken. And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven."

▶ Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:

- **Joel 2:30-31** – "The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood."
- **Isaiah 13:10** – "For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light."

H. The Rapture or Gathering of the Saints

◆ Matthew 24:31 / Mark 13:27

"And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other."

▶ Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:

- **Isaiah 26:19-21** – "Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee."
- **Psalms 27:5** – "For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion."

I. The Final Judgment

◆ Matthew 25:31-46

"And before him shall be gathered all nations: and he shall separate them one from another, as a shepherd divideth his sheep from the goats."

▶ Parallel Old Testament Prophecies:

- **Daniel 7:9-10** – "The judgment was set, and the books were opened."
- **Joel 3:12-14** – "Let the heathen be wakened... for there will I sit to judge all the heathen round about."

Summary

Jesus' End-Times Prophecies in Order:

1. **Signs of the End (Birth Pains)** – False messiahs, wars, disasters.
2. **Deception & Persecution** – False teachers, global hatred of believers.
3. **Gospel Preached to All Nations** – A last call before judgment.
4. **The Abomination of Desolation** – The Antichrist in the temple.
5. **The Great Tribulation** – Unmatched suffering.
6. **Cosmic Disturbances** – Darkened sun, blood moon, falling stars.
7. **The Second Coming & The Rapture** – Jesus gathers His elect.

8. **The Final Judgment** – The sheep (righteous) and goats (wicked) are separated.

- **Isaiah, Daniel, Joel, Zephaniah, Psalms, and Jeremiah** all contain **foreshadows** of Jesus' prophecies, especially regarding **judgment, cosmic signs, and deliverance of the faithful**.
